Why Does R3 Matter to NYSCC

- Declining license sales = less money for wildlife and fisheries conservation management and research
- Sportsmen Club and Federation membership across the state is in decline
- Decreased membership=decreased influence in local, state, and federal policy making
- Traditional and wholesome rural and outdoor life ways are in decline (serious public health concern) "It's R3 or Die"

What should NYSCC's primary objective be in the R3 arena? (discussion)

- 1. Advocate for a policy statement representing all clubs and federations coming from the council to allocate a significant budget line item in the DEC budget for R3
- 2. Attempt to initiate R3 efforts on our own as a council
- 3. Develop a R3 program incubator apparatus that includes partnership dollars from agencies, partner organizations, local municipalities, and school districts
- 4. Other ideas?
